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Structure, format and rules of the text (book chapter):

Only proposals with a scientific structure (introduction, methodology and method, results and discussion) of high impact, original and unpublished will be accepted. To ensure the quality and rigour of the publication, all accepted chapters will undergo a blind peer review process.

Papers may be submitted in **Portuguese, English and Spanish** and the abstract must be presented in the original language of the text with translation into English and Spanish. Texts from up to 3 authors will be accepted.

The text will have a maximum length of **4,500 words** (including abstract, references, tables and figures and annexes). It will be written in Arial 12p, single-spaced. Structure: Title (maximum 70 characters) and optional subtitle with a maximum of 50 characters. Abstract (max. 200 words) and keywords (max. 5 separated by ;) written in two of the official languages. Content: Introduction, design and method, results, discussion and conclusions. References should be included at the end of the text and should comply, as well as tables, illustrations, and graphs, with APA 7th edition.
